



Seek the Next Horizon

Any motorcycle carrying the Ténéré name has a lot to live up to. The model was first introduced in the mid-1980s and was a dominant force at the infamous Paris Dakar Rally. The Ténéré 700 Rally is the latest motorcycle to wear the name with pride. It's more than a badge, it's an ethos and a promise to customers. As the ultimate lightweight adventure bike, it's been designed for discerning riders who want to tackle the toughest terrain.

With styling and a heritage livery paying homage to those legendary Dakar winning Ténéré's of the 1980s, there's no doubting the Ténéré 700 Rally follows in the tyre tracks of giants. Ergonomics are optimized for optimal control and performance, with the fuel tank design and narrow rally seat maximizing knee grip when standing on the rally-spec serrated titanium footpegs. This is the motorcycle with which Yamaha's official rally raid team takes on the toughest terrain in the world. Put simply, it's a Ténéré. It's tough.

The symbiosis of rider and machine requires a motorcycle which prioritises strength, simplicity and adaptability. The Ténéré 700 Rally embraces this philosophy. The YCC-T electronic throttle system brings with it a new level of adjustability with features like ride modes, traction control and switchable ABS all coming as standard. Two throttle maps can be selected, while ABS and TCS can be easily switched off when required – giving the expert rider full control when the going gets tough, keeping a motorcycle which is pure, uncomplicated and in line with the concept which has made the Ténéré an icon for over four decades.

Seek the Next Horizon

When you ride the Ténéré 700 Rally you're riding the ultimate adventure bike for off-road riding. Powered by Yamaha's award-winning CP2 engine and housed in a tough yet lightweight steel frame designed to take on the toughest terrain, the Rally takes the Ténéré 700 to a new level. With fully adjustable rally developed suspension from KYB, 255mm of ground clearance and a specification designed to give the rider ultimate control in the most extreme conditions, it's a motorcycle for those who want to live life without limits.

Featuring rally-bred technology including fully adjustable long travel KYB front forks with strengthened tubes, a 4mm aluminum sump guard, lightweight serrated titanium footpegs and slimline bodywork, the Ténéré 700 Rally is one seriously purposeful adventure bike. Distinguishing this Rally version is a unique heritage-inspired colour scheme with gold coloured wheels and Yamaha's iconic speed block design, topped off with the high level front mudguard synonymous with desert racers.

With a dominating saddle height of 910mm, the Ténéré 700 Rally's new seat, re-designed fuel tank and modified clutch cover offer more flexibility for you to move around off-road. The cockpit features a new 6.3" TFT dashboard, which comes with a unique 'Raid' layout that presents only the most relevant information you need when taking on the most challenging terrain. Displayed in the style of a rally road book, it's one of three dashboard layouts and just one of the ways in which you can personalize your riding experience and adapt it to the conditions.



Fully adjustable long travel KYB front forks

The Ténéré 700 Rally features high end, fully-adjustable 43mm KYB front forks. With strengthened tubes and a special coating to reduce stiction, the fork stroke is increased by 20mm over the standard Ténéré 700, to give a front wheel travel of 230mm and a massive 255mm of ground clearance.



Rear shock with increased stroke and full adjustability

Designed to work in perfect harmony with the front forks, the Ténéré 700 Rally's rear suspension unit is engineered to excel in the harshest conditions. Offering 220mm of wheel travel, 20mm more than the standard Ténéré 700, it features a completely redesigned rear linkage and shock absorber. A large bump stop is used to handle rough terrain, while the unit features a piggyback reservoir with aluminium body to keep internal oil temperature down for consistent damping in all conditions. As you would expect, it is fully adjustable, with a hand adjuster allowing preload to be changed without any tools.



Exclusive heritage livery

Celebrating the storied history of the Ténéré, the Ténéré 700 Rally pays homage to the past with a stunning 80s heritage livery, complemented by gold coloured spoke wheels and Yamaha's iconic speedblock design. With its high level front fender and classic Ténéré silhouette, there's no mistaking the DNA of this real adventure motorcycle, built for the most discerning riders.



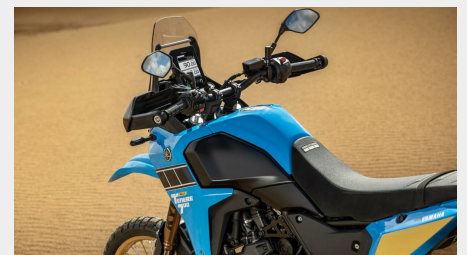
High level rally front fender

Completing the distinctive Ténéré look is the iconic high level front fender. Colour matched and designed to be practical as well as beautiful, the higher fender reduces mud splatter in sloppy conditions and eliminates the risk of mud clogging between the tyre and guard.



Dedicated one-piece rally seat

Unique to this model, the dedicated one-piece rally seat offers a slightly higher and more upright riding position than the saddle found on the standard Ténéré 700. Additional padding combines with the taller suspension to give a commanding 910mm seat height, 35mm higher than standard, with the premium dual material cover coming embossed with a Rally logo. The saddle is shaped to offer greater off-road control while standing, while also increasing comfort in the seated position.



Off-road focused ergonomics

The Ténéré 700 Rally has been carefully updated to offer an even greater sense of unity between rider and machine. The new fuel tank has been moved forward and the fuel cap sits lower for improved weight distribution, while the shape is narrower to offer improved knee grip for maximum control on all kinds of surfaces. This is complemented by the flat rally seat which is narrow and makes it easy to shift your weight around when riding off road.
